The following are the main changes to the substance of the existing rules – other than changes to format.

Page 1

- Amendments moved to last page

Page 2

- Added descriptions for Life and Honorary Membership

Page 3 – Membership

- Changes made to application for membership to no longer requiring to be Proposed and Seconded by club members.

- Additional discounts added

Page 4 – General Meetings

- AGM format described

- Same conditions as apply to the AGM also apply to an SGM - changed paras 7 – 8 to comply. Paras 9-10 already infer application to both AGM & SGM.

Note – Dates for AGM changed from November to September - we believe this has already been agreed at a previous AGM but currently no written evidence of this.

Page 5 - Management

Suggest

- Rename Secretary as 'Club Secretary'
- Combine / Clubhouse and Clubhouse Maintenance Sec
- Combine BC Sec and Club Sec

Given the depleted Committee numbers can we review the number needed for a quorum – Suggest ½ of the elected committee members – currently 5 with the Committee being 11 individuals currently

Suggest the following:

Ensure all job roles (to be kept) are listed in Index / Para 11 & as detailed descriptions

Add new roles for - Clothing / Kit Secretary and Welfare Officer

Remove reference to the following roles:

Club Events Secretary - as all events fall under Social, TT, Open Road Race etc

Publicity Secretary – as duplication of roles under Communications Secretary

Mountain Bike Secretary – as this is just another type of cycling activity

Expand Time Trial Recorder to cover all results (TT / Race / Open) as 'Results Secretary'

Remove the following roles :

Road Race / Time Trial & Open Event Coordinators

as coordination roles to fall under the Captains (BRRT / Men's / Ladies)

as the recording role falls under 'Results Secretary'

BC Secretary

as Individuals are responsible for Race Licences

as Go-Ride responsibility part of Go-Ride Sec Role

Note that the index includes the following not provided for in the detailed roles:

Assistant Secretary / Publicity Secretary

Note that the details include the following roles not in the index:

*Membership Secretary / * Road Racing Coordinator / * Time Trial Coordinator / * Club Run Coordinator

Trophy descriptions simplified and streamlines

Regarding the Road Race Trophy – the following revision was made but has never been amended in the rules...

Noted by Terry Bush:

Change of rule.

To bring the Club rule in line with National Policy, the Committee recommend that the following rule:-

The Road Racing Trophy ...

Shall be changed to read:-

The Road Race Trophy

The Trophy will be awarded to the rider who obtains the most British Cycling ranking points for that season. (points are accumulated until 31st December)

Races entered outside of the Central League are awarded to individuals but not to the Club. Riders are advised to inform the Committee of any such races they have entered.

In the event that no ranking points are scored, the person said to best represent the Club will be based on the number of races entered, regardless of finishing position.

In the case of any rider scoring points, the accumulated race entries shall count for nothing.

Any First Claim member in the age categories of Junior, Senior and Veteran, as defined by British Cycling, is eligible for the award.

Two trophies are awarded. One for Best Female, one for Best Male.
